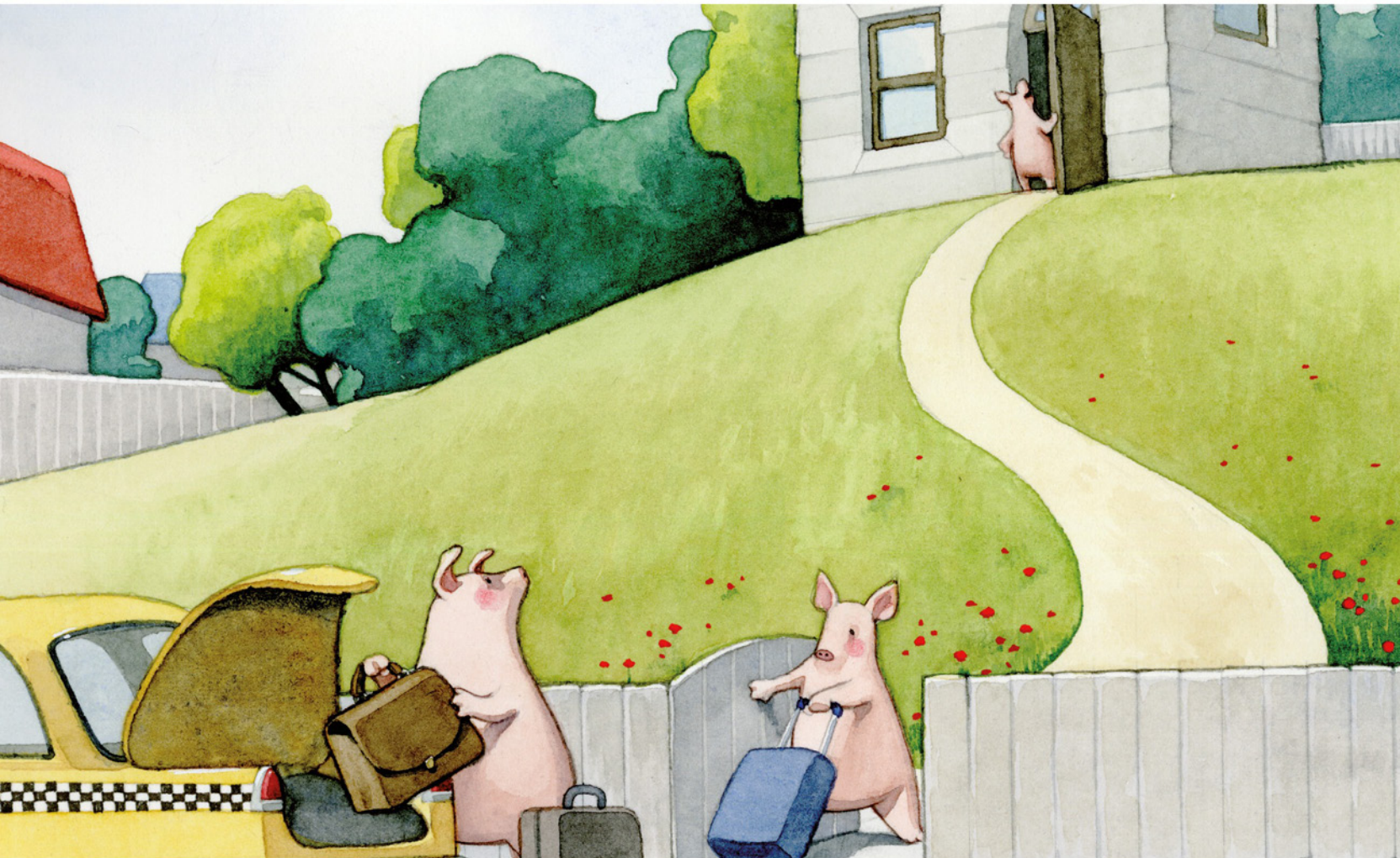




# THREE TOUGH LITTLE PIGS

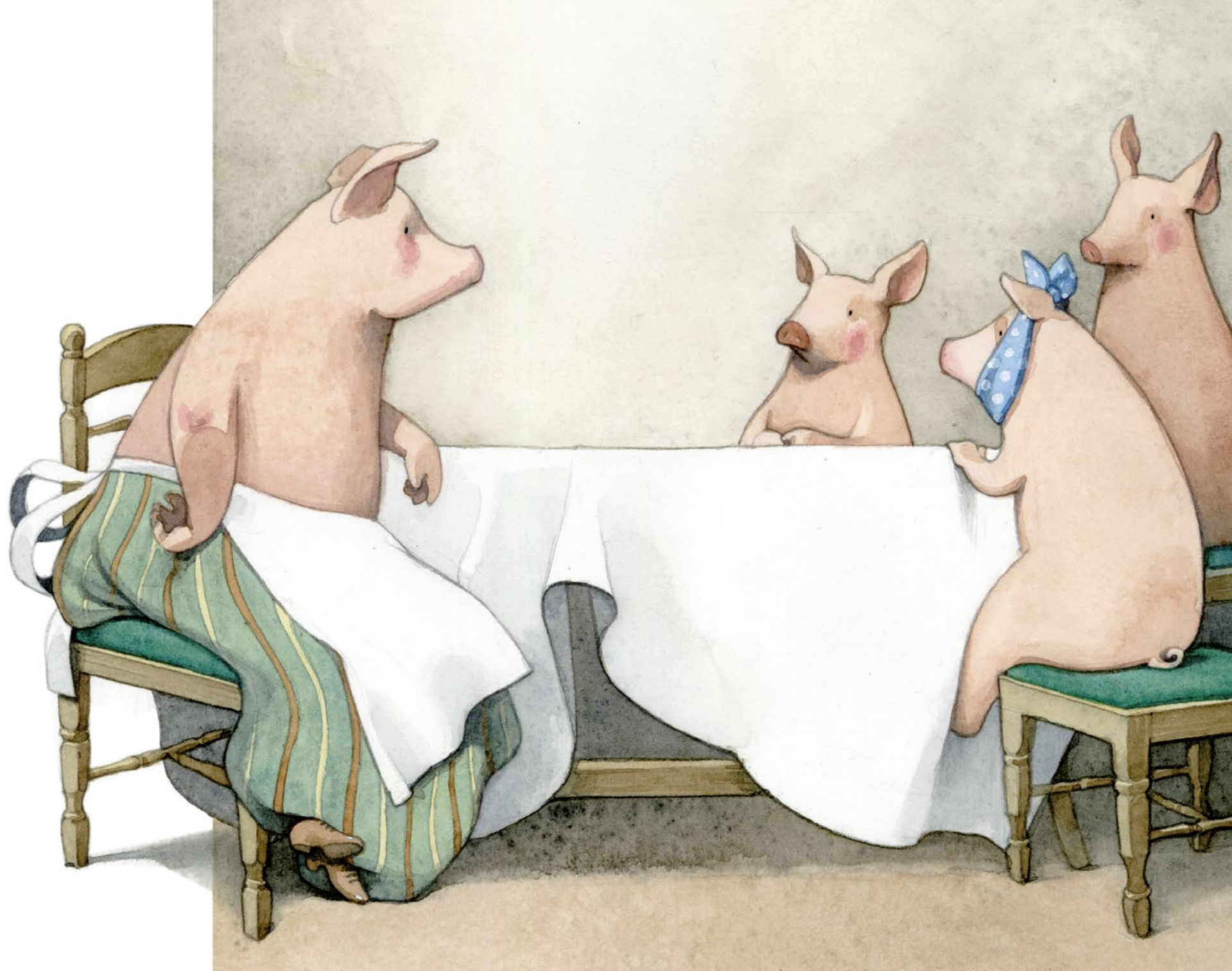
Once upon a time Mama Pig called her three little pigs together and asked them to sit with her around the table.
